

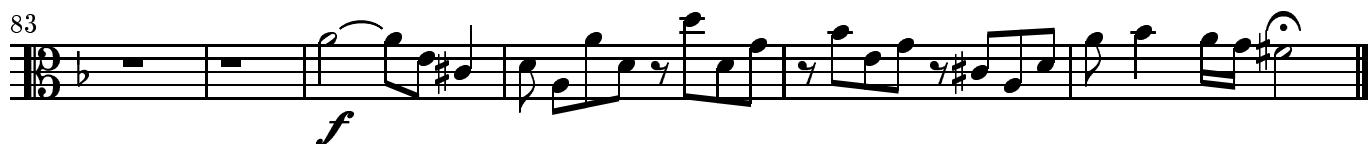
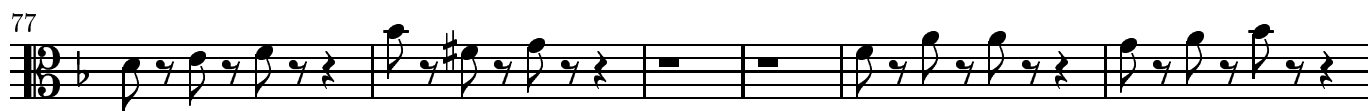
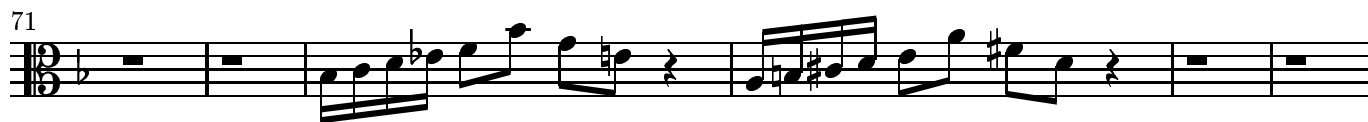
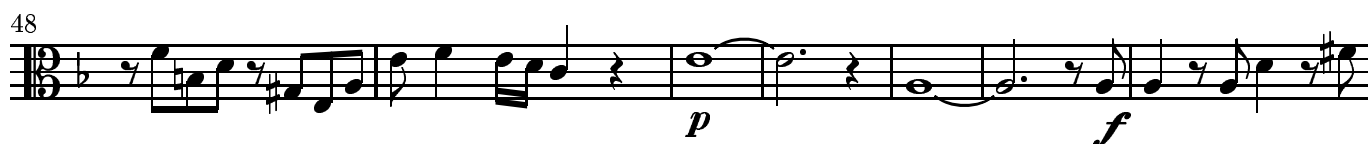
# Concerto in D minor

JOHANN SEBASTIAN BACH (1685-1750)

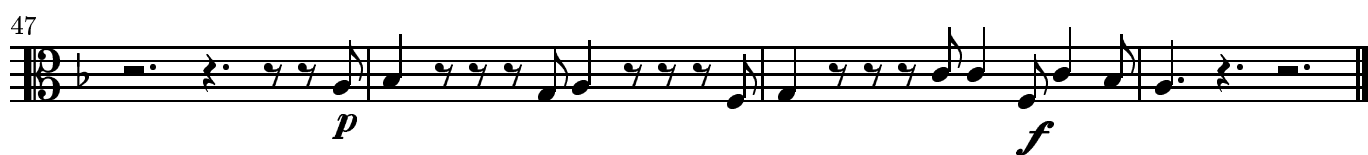
VIVACE
